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happy easter outdoor wreath

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SUPPLIES & TOOLS:

- Plaid[®] FolkArt[®] Outdoor[™] paints:
Lemon Custard, Light Blue, Baby Pink,
Fresh Foliage, Purple Lilac, Burnt Umber
- Plaid[®] Simply[®] mini laser stencil
- 12" grapevine wreath
- Wood Slat, 7³/₄" x 2¹/₆" x 3/16"
- 5 wood eggs, 2.5"
- Sheet moss
- Wood birdhouse, 5¹/₂"
- Wood cross
- Wood filler
- Hot glue
- Paint brush
- Stencil brush
- Sandpaper

DIRECTIONS:

1. Remove string from cross and fill hole with wood filler; set aside.
2. Sand rough edges of wood slat, birdhouse and cross.
3. Paint slat Light Blue; dry.
4. Paint each egg a different color; dry and decorate. Refer to photo. Use all colors except Burnt Umber.
5. Paint birdhouse Lemon Custard, roof Light Blue, and base Fresh Foliage. Let dry, then decorate.
6. Paint inside of cross Purple Lilac. When dry, paint outside of cross Fresh Foliage; dry.
7. With a dry brush, paint inside of cross with Baby Pink. Paint dots along outside of cross with Lemon Custard and add smaller dots with Light Blue; dry.
8. Use a ruler and pencil to make 1/8" wide stripes on the border of sign. Paint stripes with Fresh Foliage and Baby Pink; dry.
9. Stencil "Happy Easter" with Burnt Umber then float Burnt Umber along edges of sign.
10. Use hot glue to attach cross to sign, eggs to wreath and birdhouse to inside center of wreath.
